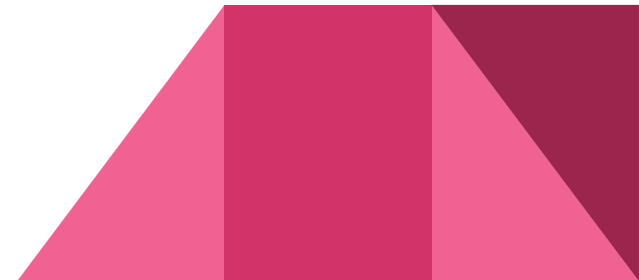

Interactive Focusing - for improving relationship, especially for accomplishment of the shared purpose

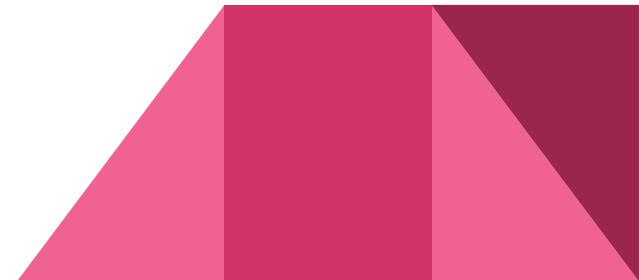

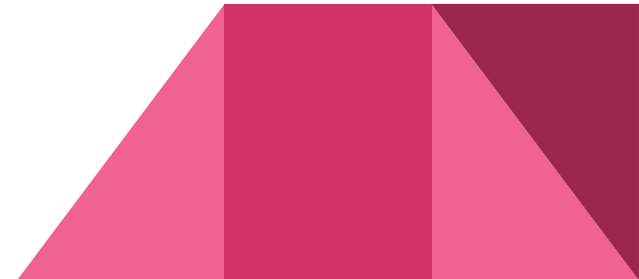

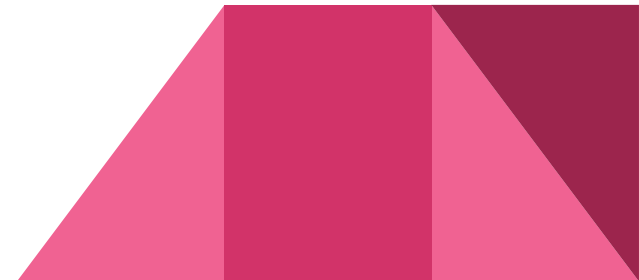


Women's Trust High School Scholarship Recipients
